Accessories: SNAIL Adhesive #104332, Simply Scored #122334, Big Shot #113439, Apothecary Accents Framelits #127003, Chevron Embossing Folder #127749, Blender Pens #102845, Early Espresso Cotton Ribbon #134560, Sponge #101610.

Cutting Measurements:

- Mossy Meadow: 4 ¼" X 11" for the card, scored at 5 ¼".
- Very Vanilla: 3" X 5" Cut with Apothecary Die
- Crumb Cake DSP: 4 1/4" X 1 1/4"
- Early Espresso Ribbon 13"

Instructions:

- 1. Stamp the tree/boat image with Staz On Ink. Close pad right away as it dries quickly.
- 2. Stamp the greeting with Early Espresso
- 3. Sponge the edges of Vanilla piece with Crumb Cake
- **4.** Color using Blender pens···I used a choppy motion for the trees and blotted off some color so that boat doesn't get too dark. For class, pens are marked for the 2 colors so that you don't have to wipe off the marker tip in between colors to speed up process and save on pens.
- **5.** Use SNAIL to adhere the DSP to the right side of your card.
- **6.** Tie Espresso ribbon around front of card and secure with a knot at top front.
- 7. Attach 4 dimensionals to Vanilla piece and apply to card…you are finished.
